

ENGLAND BOXING NATIONAL SCHOOLS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2019 – KEY INFORMATION CIRCULAR

General Information

Welcome to the information circular for the England Boxing National Junior Championships, to be held in Crawley on Saturday 18th & Sunday 19th May. This circular will address operational and logistical matters relating to the event and hopefully answer any queries you have at this stage.

This event is for Male and Female Schools boxers at Class A, Class B and Cadets. It will be staged at the K2 Crawley, Pottage Hill, Crawley, RH11 9BQ.

The semi-finals will be on Saturday 18th and the finals will be on Sunday 19th. These final stages of the event are staged by England Boxing, but we would like to recognise and thank all those involved in the regional rounds in the run-up to this weekend.

Timings

Saturday 18th May: session one start – 1pm. Break – 3.30pm. Session two start – 4pm. Sunday 19th May: session one start – 12noon. No break in boxing.

Accreditation

Boxers and Coaches – Accreditation wrist bands will issued to boxers and coaches at their first weigh-in. Thereafter, a daily wristband will be issued for boxers and coaches competing that day at weigh-in. You will need to be in possession of your wrist band to access the field of play.

Venue Access

When not competing, boxers and coaches will be allowed to enter the venue to watch the boxing from the stands with their accreditation wristbands, but will not be allowed onto the field of play.

Weigh-in

The weigh-ins will take place at the K2 Centre, Crawley for all weight categories.

Saturday 18th May: 10am to 12noon.

Sunday 18th May: 9am to 11am.

Boxers and coaches should be at the venue in good time to be weighed in and to carry out their medicals. Please ensure you bring your medical cards and gumshields with you (no red or partially red). Please note that due to the number of boxers entered in the event **only one coach** from any one club will allowed to enter the weigh in room with their boxer(s). Coaches are to make sure that their EB lanyards are in date and they bring them to the event. Only coaches of the same gender can enter the weighin room with their boxer.

Please also note that boxers only need to weigh-in on the day they are boxing. Please be advised that any boxer who does not weigh-in and medical on the day they are required to do so will be withdrawn from the Championships.

Programme

The official draw will be released on Wednesday 15th May.

There will be three boxing rings in place on both days.

Please note that the programme will be dependent on all boxers making the weight and passing the doctors examination. The confirmed bout order for each day will be promulgated on completion of the draw on the England Boxing website.

Box Office

Tickets can be purchased at the ticket desk at the K2 Centre. Prices are £20 per adult, £10 per concession (over-65s) and £5 per child (6 to 15-year-olds). Under 5s are free. Please note it is cash only and there is not an ATM at the venue. Entry for spectators is from 12noon on Saturday and 11am on Sunday.

Please note that an England Boxing photographer and videographer will be capturing footage on all days of the event that may include capturing images of spectators.

Parking

There is significant free parking at the K2 Centre and close by car parks. Attendants are in place.

England Talent

All Class B and Class A champions will be brought onto the England Talent Programme. You must report to the Talent Desk to complete a registration form or your place on the programme will be at risk.
