Introduction:

England Boxing is the national governing body for amateur boxing, one of the oldest sports in the world, and one which has featured in the ancient and modern Olympics since 1904. Its mission is to “protect, promote and support amateur boxing in England at all levels.” It does this through promotion, development and administration of the sport from grass roots through to the England talent pathway and in turn passing prospective medalists to GB Boxing. It also represents England as a member of the International Boxing Association (AIBA) and the European Boxing Council (EUBC).

With a history going back to 1880 and its first national championship taking place in 1881, England Boxing represents more than 17,500 members across over 900 affiliated clubs and is committed to maximising the potential of the sport both through National competitions and events, training and playing a full role in the local communities the Clubs represent.

Clearly stated ambitions in England Boxing’s strategy include the provision of enhanced support to the membership, in particular the delivery of comprehensive, consistent, industry leading training and learning opportunities for coaches, officials and other volunteers within the sport.

Since the inception of the England Boxing Level 1 Coaching Course, over 4000 new coaches have been qualified. Following feedback from our clubs and members, we have changed the way in which a New Level 1 Coach is approved on the Vault which will allow the Club greater control over New Coaches making applications.

The purpose of this document is to give a step by step guide to registering a new level 1 coach at the following access level:

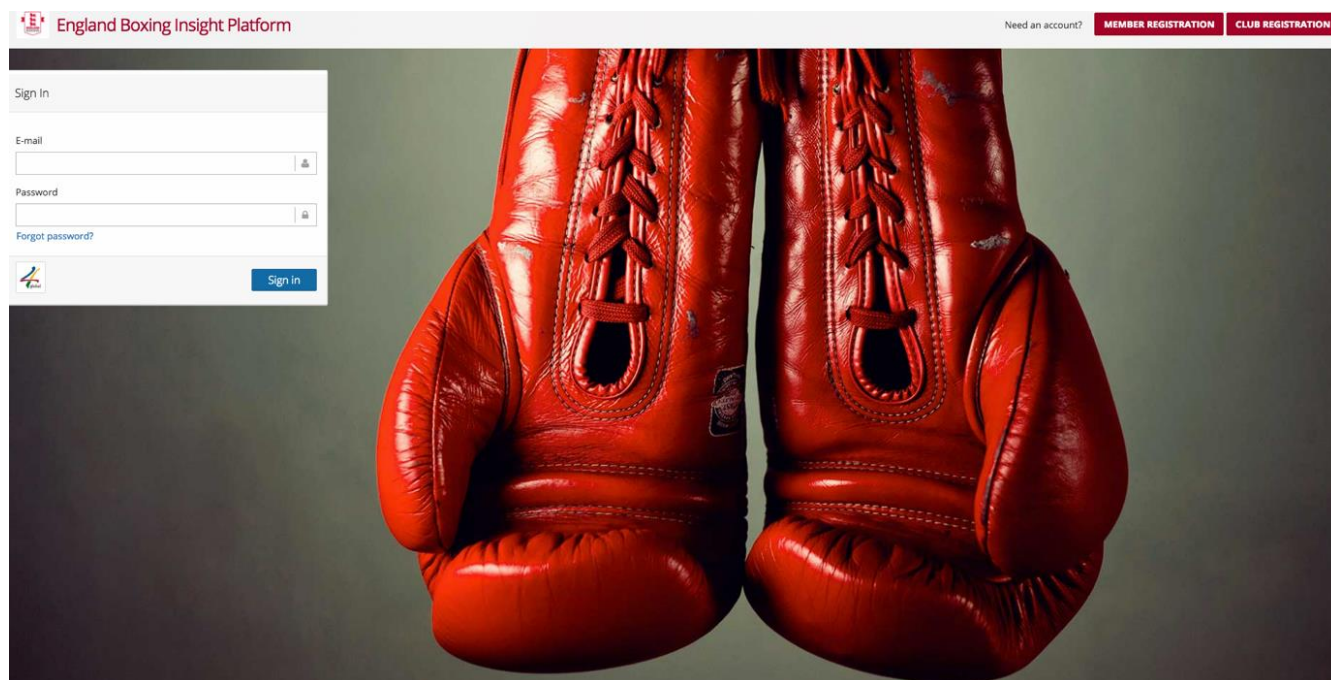
