



ENGLAND BOXING WOMEN'S WINTER BOX CUP 2019 – EVENT INFORMATION

1) Date and venue

Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th December 2019 at the Guildford Spectrum, Parkway, GU1 1UP.

2) General Information

Welcome to the event information for the England Boxing Women's Winter Box Cup. This document will address operational and logistical matters relating to the event and hopefully answer any queries you have at this stage.

This event is for female, Junior, Youth and Senior boxers.

3) Accreditation

Accreditation wristbands will be issued each day to boxers and coaches at weigh-in. Accreditation will only be given to those registered on the online Jablinked system used to enter the competition.

Accreditation will only be issued upon the coach showing a valid ID card and in-date DBS.

Boxers are to exchange their old wristband for a new one when removing them to box.

You will need to be in possession of your wristband to access the field of play.

4) Venue Access

When not competing, registered boxers and coaches will be allowed to enter the venue to watch the boxing from the stands with their accreditation wristbands, but will not be allowed onto the field of play.

Boxers/coaches should please enter through the main doors. The spectators' entrance is also through the main entrance. England Boxing signage will be present.

5) Weigh-in

All boxers are required to attend weigh-in Saturday 7th December 8am-10am.
Boxers in the final to attend weigh-in again Sunday 8th December 8am-10am.

The weigh-in will take place in the squash courts at Guildford Spectrum on both days. Please see rules and guidelines for weight allowances.

Boxers and coaches should be at the venue in good time to be weighed in and to carry out their medicals. Please ensure you bring your medical cards and gumshields with you (no red or partially red).

Please note that due to the number of boxers entered in the event, only one coach of the same gender from any one club will be allowed to enter the weigh in room with their boxer(s). Coaches are to make sure that their EB lanyards are in date and they bring them to the event.

Please be advised that any boxer who does not weigh-in and medical on the day and time they are required to do so will be withdrawn from the competition. Notification of any withdrawals will be given to affected clubs as soon as possible and posted online.

6) Programme

The programme/bout list will be announced after the announcement of the draw (which will be made by 11am on Saturday, shortly following the completion of weigh-ins at 10am).

Three rings will be in place on both days.

On Saturday 7th December, boxing is to commence at 12pm. The session break will be from 2.30pm to 3pm.

On Sunday 8th December, boxing is to commence at 11am. The session break will be from 1.30pm to 2pm.

Please note that the programme will be dependent on all boxers making the weight and passing the doctor's examination.

7) Box Office

Tickets can be purchased at the Ticket Desk in Guildford Spectrum on the day of competition only. Prices are £20 per adult, £10 per concession (over 65), £5 per child (five to 15-year-olds) four and under free. Please note it is cash only and no £50 notes will be accepted.

8) Photography

Please note that an England Boxing photographer and videographer will be capturing footage on both days of the event that may include capturing images of spectators. By attending as a spectator, you agree this imagery can be used by England Boxing and other media outlets.

9) Parking

There is free parking available at the venue.
