



ENGLAND BOXING NATIONAL AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2022 FINALS DAY KEY INFORMATION CIRCULAR

1) General Information

Welcome to the key information circular for the England Boxing National Amateur Championships 2022 Finals Day, to be held in Manchester on Saturday 23rd April.

This circular will address operational and logistical matters relating to the event and hopefully answer any queries you have at this stage.

This event is for male and female boxers, and will be held at the Manchester Central Convention Complex, Windmill Street, Manchester, M2 3GX.

These final stages of the event are staged by England Boxing, but we would like to recognise the extensive work put in by all those involved in the regional rounds in the run-up to this weekend, and thank them for their efforts.

2) Timings

Saturday 23rd April 2022

Boxing commences: 1pm. A 30-minute break will then take place from 4pm until 4.30 pm.

3) Accreditation

Accreditation wrist bands will be issued to boxers and coaches at their weigh-in.

You will need to be in possession of your wrist band to access the field of play. Coaches must present and wear their current England Boxing lanyard at all times. No more than three coaches per boxer will be permitted into the venue (any club with more than five boxers competing will be allowed up to a maximum of six coaches).

5) Weigh-in

The weigh-ins will take place at the Manchester Central for all weight categories. Timings are as below:

Saturday 23rd April 2022

10am to 12noon.

Boxers and coaches should be at the venue in good time to be weighed in and to carry out their medicals. The scales will close at 12noon on 23rd April.

Please ensure you bring your medical cards and gumshields with you (no red or partially red). Please note that due to the number of boxers entered in the event, **only one coach** from any one club will allowed to enter the weigh-in room with their boxer(s).

Coaches are to make sure that their England Boxing lanyards are in date and they bring them to the event. Only coaches of the same gender can enter the weigh-in room with their boxer. **No coach will be allowed in the Field of Play or any coaching areas without displaying a current and fully in-date lanyard with valid First Aid and DBS dates.**

Please be advised that any boxer who does not weigh-in and medical will be withdrawn from the Championships.

6) Programme

The official bout list has already been released on the England Boxing website and advertised as such on social media.

Please check back regularly in the lead-up to the event in case of withdrawals.

There will be one ring in place at the venue.

Please note that the programme will be dependent on all boxers making the weight and passing the doctor's examination.

Certificates

As part of England Boxing's drive to be more environmentally friendly, competition certificates will be supplied in an online PDF format only and will be emailed to the recipient after the event has finished, which can then be printed off if so desired.

7) Box Office

Prices are £20 per adult, £10 per concession (over 65) and £5 per child aged six to 15, with Under-5s are free. Please note there is not an ATM at the venue. **We cannot accept £50 notes.**

Once in the arena, spectators are reminded that they must remain seated at all times and not stand up against the ring barriers.

Should spectators stand, boxing will be stopped and will not continue until everyone is sat down. Please adhere to this instruction, not just out of respect for others, but also for everyone's health and safety.

Please note that England Boxing photographers and videographers will be capturing footage on both days of the event that may include capturing images of spectators. By attending as a spectator, you agree this imagery can be used by England Boxing and other media outlets.

8) Parking

There is a pay and display car park at Manchester Central. The postcode to use is **M2 3GX**

9) England Talent

All boxers who have reached this stage will be formally invited to a GB Boxing assessment.

10) Live streaming

If you can't attend on the day to take in the action, then you can watch things unfold via online streaming on the BBC Sport website, app and BBC iPlayer, with further details to be announced in the lead-up to the event.
