



ENGLAND BOXING NATIONAL SCHOOLS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2022 – KEY INFORMATION CIRCULAR

1) General Information

Welcome to the key information circular for the England Boxing National Schools 2022 Championships, to be held in Banbury on Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th May 2022.

This circular will address operational and logistical matters relating to the event and hopefully answer any queries you have at this stage.

This event is for male and female Schools Class A and B and Schools Cadet boxers, and will be held at the Spiceball Leisure Centre, Cherwell Drive, Banbury, OX16 2BW.

The semi-finals will be on Saturday 14th May and the finals will be on Sunday 15th May. These final stages of the event are staged by England Boxing, but we would like to recognise the extensive work put in by all those involved in the regional rounds in the run-up to this weekend, and thank them for their efforts.

2) Timings

Saturday 14th May 2022

Boxing commences: 12.30pm. A 30-minute break will then take place in each ring at these times: Ring A – 3.30pm. Rings B and C – 4pm. **Doors open to the public 11.30am.**

Sunday 15th May 2022

Boxing commences: 12noon. A 30-minute break will then take place in each ring at these times: Rings A and B – 2.30pm. Ring C – 3pm. **Doors open to the public 11am.**

3) Accreditation

Accreditation wrist bands will issued to boxers and coaches at their weigh-in. Thereafter, a daily wristband will be issued for boxers and coaches competing that day at their weigh-in.

You will need to be in possession of your wristband to access the field of play. Coaches must present and wear their current England Boxing lanyard at all times. No more than three coaches per boxer will be permitted into the venue (any club with more than five boxers competing will be allowed up to a maximum of six coaches).

5) Weigh-in

The weigh-ins will take place at the Spiceball Centre for all weight categories. Timings are as below:

Saturday 14th May 2022

9am to 11am.

Sunday 15th May 2022

9am to 11am.

Boxers and coaches should be at the venue in good time to be weighed in and to carry out their medicals. The scales will close at 11am on 14th May and at 11am on 15th May.

Please ensure you bring your medical cards and gumshields with you (no red or partially red). Please note that due to the number of boxers entered in the event, **only one coach** from any one club will be allowed to enter the weigh-in room with their boxer(s).

Coaches are to make sure that their England Boxing lanyards are in-date and they bring them to the event. Only coaches of the same gender can enter the weigh-in room with their boxer. **No coach will be allowed in the Field of Play or any coaching areas without displaying a current and fully in-date lanyard with valid First Aid and DBS dates.**

Please also note that boxers only need to weigh-in on the day they are boxing.

Please be advised that any boxer who does not weigh-in and medical on the day they are required to do so will be withdrawn from the Championships.

6) Programme

The official draw will be released by Wednesday 11th May 2022 on the England Boxing website and advertised as such on social media.

There will be three boxing rings in place on both days.

Please note that the programme will be dependent on all boxers making the weight and passing the doctor's examination.

The confirmed bout order for each day will be promulgated on completion of the draw for the semi-finals and, following those results, for the finals.

7) Box Office

Tickets can be purchased at the Ticket Desk at the Spiceball Leisure Centre. Prices are £20 per adult, £10 per concession (over 65) and £5 per child aged six to 15, with Under-5s are free. Please note there is not an ATM at the venue, however we can accept card payments as well as cash. **We cannot accept £50 notes.**

Once in the arena, spectators are reminded that they must remain seated at all times and not stand up against the ring barriers.

Should spectators stand, boxing will be stopped and will not continue until everyone is sat down. Please adhere to this instruction, not just out of respect for others, but also for everyone's health and safety.

Please note that England Boxing photographers and videographer will be capturing footage on both days of the event that may include capturing images of spectators. By attending as a spectator, you agree this imagery can be used by England Boxing and other media outlets.

8) Parking

There is no parking available at the venue. The town centre is a short walk where there are a host of pay and display car parks.

9) England Talent

All Class B and Class A finalists at the England Boxing National Schools Championships 2022. will be brought onto the England Talent Schools Academy. The first camp takes place in early June.

All finalists must complete the boxer registration form at the event using the QR code, so that further communications can be sent. Failure to do so could put your place on the Academy at risk.

All Cadet champions will be invited to a 'Cadet Champions Day' in June at the English Institute of Sport in Sheffield.

10) Live streaming

If you can't attend on the day to take in the action, then you can watch things unfold via online streaming on the England Boxing YouTube Channel, with further details to be announced in the lead-up to the event.
