The sub-committee meets every other month, both virtually and face-to-face, sharing knowledge and engaging with the regional associations.

The sub-committee reports directly to the England Boxing Board and is chaired by England Boxing director Sam Foster.

Committee scope

The purpose of the Clubs and Membership sub-committee is to:

- Make recommendations to the Board with regards to clubs and membership
- Listen to the regional associations, and draw out improvements, enhancements and the sharing of knowledge.
- Act to support, promote and develop boxing in clubs, schools, colleges and universities.

- Act to support England Boxing and the clubs in their aim to provide a stimulating environment for their members, taking particular note of equity, disability, female and welfare issues.
- Work alongside the other sub-committees to make recommendations as appropriate
- Establish a focus on young people in the sport and actively and formally seek the views of boxers, athletes and young people involved in the sport.

This is a voluntary (unpaid) position, but reasonable out-of-pocket expenses will be reimbursed for travel to meetings, etc, although meetings generally take place online via Zoom or Microsoft Teams.
