



## PERFORMANCE PATHWAY CASUAL PHYSIOTHERAPIST – ENGLAND BOXING

### Introduction and background

England Boxing's Performance Pathway has been successful in delivering medals at all age grades, male and female, at World and European Championships, as well as the Youth Olympic Games.

England boxing is now accepting applications from physiotherapists who wish to be involved in the performance pathway. This is an exciting opportunity for a physiotherapist to expand their knowledge and experience in elite sport, working closely with England Boxing performance coaches and athletes.

The main role of the successful applicants will be providing physio support to England Boxing athletes at weekend training camps held in Sheffield. Training camps are held monthly prior to squad selection for Major Championships, at which point there will be training camps every weekend.

The successful candidate wouldn't be expected to be available for all weekends, but a minimum availability of one to two weekends per month would be preferred.
