



ENGLAND BOXING NATIONAL AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2023 PRE QUARTER-FINALS – KEY INFORMATION CIRCULAR

1) General Information

Welcome to the key information circular for the England Boxing National Amateur Championships 2023 pre quarter-finals, to be held in Barnsley on Saturday 1st April 2022.

This circular will address operational and logistical matters relating to the event and hopefully answer any queries you have at this stage.

This event is for male and female Senior Elite boxers, and will be held at the Barnsley Metrodome, Queens Ground, Queens Road, Barnsley, S71 1AN.

These stages of the event are staged by England Boxing, but we would like to recognise the extensive work put in by all those involved in the regional rounds in the run-up to this point, and thank them for their efforts.

2) Timings

Saturday 1st April 2022

Boxing commences: 12noon.

3) Accreditation

Accreditation wrist bands will issued to boxers and coaches at their weigh-in.

You will need to be in possession of your wrist band to access the field of play. Coaches must present and wear their current England Boxing lanyard at all times. No more than three coaches per boxer will be permitted into the venue (any club with more than five boxers competing will be allowed up to a maximum of six coaches).

4) Weigh-in

The weigh-ins will take place at the Barnsley Metrodome for all weight categories. Timings are as below:

Saturday 1st April 2022

9am to 11am.

Boxers and coaches should be at the venue in good time to be weighed in and to carry out their medicals. The scales will close at 11am on 1st April.

Please ensure you bring your medical cards and gumshields with you (no red or partially red). Please note that due to the number of boxers entered in the event, **only one coach** from any one club will be allowed to enter the weigh-in room with their boxer(s).

Coaches are to make sure that their England Boxing lanyards are in-date and they bring them to the event. Only coaches of the same gender can enter the weigh-in room with their boxer. **No coach will be allowed in the Field of Play or any coaching areas without displaying a current and fully in-date lanyard with valid First Aid and DBS dates.**

Please also note that boxers only need to weigh-in on the day they are boxing.

Please be advised that any boxer who does not weigh-in and medical on the day they are required to do so will be withdrawn from the Championships.

5) Programme

The official draw will be released by Wednesday 29th March 2023 on the England Boxing website and advertised as such on social media.

There will be two boxing rings in place.

Please note that the programme will be dependent on all boxers making the weight and passing the doctor's examination.

The confirmed bout order will be promulgated on completion of the draw.

6) Box Office

Tickets can be purchased at the Ticket Desk at the Barnsley Metrodome. Prices are £20 per adult, £10 per concession (over 65) and £5 per child aged six to 15, with Under-5s free. Please note payment is by card only and cash cannot be accepted.

Once in the arena, spectators are reminded that they must remain seated at all times and not stand up against the ring barriers.

Should spectators stand, boxing will be stopped and will not continue until everyone is sat down. Please adhere to this instruction, not just out of respect for others, but also for everyone's health and safety.

Please note that England Boxing photographers and videographer will be capturing footage on both days of the event that may include capturing images of spectators. By attending as a spectator, you agree this imagery can be used by England Boxing and other media outlets.

7) Parking and travel

There is parking available at the venue and this is chargeable at £5 per vehicle.

Please note that train strikes are planned on the day in question by certain carriers, so please plan your journey well in advance if you are planning to travel by train.

8) Live streaming

If you can't attend on the day to take in the action, then you can watch things unfold via online streaming on the England Boxing YouTube Channel, with further details to be announced in the lead-up to the event.
