



## **ENGLAND BOXING – KEY INFORMATION CIRCULAR GB ELITE THREE NATIONS 2023**

### **1) General Information**

Welcome to the key information circular for the England Boxing GB Elite Three Nations 2023, to be held in Rotherham on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> May.

This event sees the finest boxers from England, Scotland, and Wales compete to be a coveted GB Three Nations champion, and England Boxing would like to congratulate all boxers on being selected to represent their country at the event.

This circular will address operational and logistical matters relating to the event and hopefully answer any queries you have at this stage.

This event is for male and female Elite boxers and will be held at The Magna Science Adventure Centre, Magna Way, Templeborough, Rotherham, S60 1FD. The semi-finals will take place on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> and the finals on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup>.

### **2) Timings**

#### Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2023

Team parades to take place at 12noon.

Boxing commences: 12.30pm. A 45-minute break will then take place in each ring at these times: Ring A – after bout 4, and Ring B – after bout 7.

#### Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2023

Boxing commences: 12noon. A 30-minute break will then take place in each ring at these times: Ring A – after bout 5, and Ring B – after bout 7.

### **3) Accreditation**

Accreditation wristbands will be issued to boxers and coaches at their weigh-in. Thereafter a daily wristband will be issued for boxers and coaches competing that day at their weigh-in.

Boxers and coaches will need to be in possession of their wristband to access the field of play. Coaches must always present and wear their current NGB Boxing lanyard. Coaches are to make sure that their NGB Boxing lanyards are in-date, and they bring them to the event.

#### **4) Weigh-in**

The weigh-ins will take place at The Magna Science Adventure Centre, Magna Way, Templeborough, Rotherham, S60 1FD for all weight categories. Timings are as below:

Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2023

8.30am to 10.30am.

Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2023

8.30am to 10.30am.

Boxers and coaches should be at the venue in good time to be weighed in and to carry out their medicals. The scales will close at 10.30am on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> May and Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> May.

Please ensure you bring your medical cards and gumshields with you (no red or partially red).

Please also note that boxers only need to weigh-in on the day they are boxing.

Please be advised that any boxer who does not weigh-in and attend the medical on the day they are required to do so will be withdrawn from the event.

#### **5) Programme**

There will be two boxing rings in place on both days.

Please note that the programme will be dependent on all boxers making the weight and passing the doctor's examination.

The confirmed bout order for each day will be promulgated on completion of the draw for the semi-finals and, following those results, for the finals.

## 6) Box Office

Tickets can be purchased at the England Boxing ticket desk on arrival at the venue. Please note we do not accept cash, and all tickets must be purchased using card payments only. The ticket prices for the England Boxing GB Elite Three Nations 2023 are listed below:

Accreditation wristbands will be issued to spectators after purchase of a valid ticket.

Once in the arena, spectators are reminded that they must remain seated at all times, and not stand up against the ring barriers.

Should spectators stand, boxing will be stopped and will not continue until everyone is sat down. Please adhere to this instruction, not just out of respect for others, but also for everyone's health and safety.

## 7) Photography

Please note that England Boxing photographers and videographer will be capturing footage on both days of the event that may include capturing images of spectators. By attending as a spectator, you agree this imagery can be used by England Boxing and other media outlets.

Any spectator wishing to take photos or videos with professional equipment who is not accredited with England Boxing will be required to sign a photography permission form on arrival. These will be available at the England Boxing ticket desk.

## 8) Car Parking

There is car parking available at the venue, free of charge. This is accessible via S60 1FD.

Please note that pedestrian access is via S60 1DX.

### **9) Live streaming**

If you can't attend on the day to take in the action, then you can watch things unfold via online streaming on the England Boxing YouTube Channel, with further details to be announced in the lead-up to the event.
