The committee meets every other month, both virtually and face-to-face, sharing knowledge and engaging with the regional associations.

The committee reports directly to the England Boxing Board and is chaired by England Boxing director Anna Cain.

## **Committee scope**

1.1 The purpose of the Workforce Development committee is to support all aspects of England Boxing's Workforce Development programme and specifically;

- To develop the England Boxing policies and strategies in relation to workforce in accordance with the overall England Boxing Strategic Plan;
- To ensure that England Boxing meets, and is seen to meet, the needs of the boxers, the clubs, and the regional associations in all aspects of coach education and development;
- To assist member clubs and regions in matters of Workforce Development and development of officials;
- To assist in ensuring England Boxing's communication with coaches, officials, clubs and regional associations with regards to championships and competitions, is effective, and meets the needs of the organisation.

This is a voluntary (unpaid) position, but reasonable out-of-pocket expenses will be reimbursed for travel to meetings, etc, although meetings generally take place online via Zoom or Microsoft Teams.
