



ENGLAND BOXING COMMUNITY APPRENTICESHIP (LEVEL 3)

FAQ'S

Q. How many hours will I be expected to work during the week?

A. The EB Community Apprenticeship is a full-time position for 15 months that will see you work 35 hours per week which includes 7hr of learning time as part of the level 3 qualification

Q. What qualification will I gain through the apprenticeship?

A. The apprenticeship includes the completion of a Community Sport and Health Officer (Level 3) qualification

Q. What will be provided in terms of career support post-apprenticeship?

A. Our apprenticeship programme includes career progression opportunities throughout the 15-month period including career fairs, opening up opportunities with sports sector employers etc...

Q. Will I be expected to work from the England Boxing office in Sheffield?

A. Our apprentices will primarily work from home or at a local boxing club. There will be meetings/training opportunities that will be based at England Boxing's office in Sheffield throughout the term of the apprenticeship
