



ENGLAND BOXING: NEW CLUB SETUP GUIDE



ASSOCIATE GYM MEMBERSHIP

If a club's Head Coach holds a **minimum of a Level 1 coaching qualification**, the club is eligible to affiliate as an **Associate Gym**. This type of membership allows the club to operate as a **non-contact gym**, meaning members can take part in training but **cannot spar or compete**.

Contact your **Regional Club Support Officer (CSO)** for guidance with the below details and to arrange a gym inspection.

If a club's Head Coach holds a **Level 2 coaching qualification**, the club is eligible to affiliate as a **First Year Club**. This status allows the club to deliver full-contact boxing, including **sparring and competitive entry**.

Gym inspection must be completed by the CSO.

Once all requirements are met, the club can affiliate
