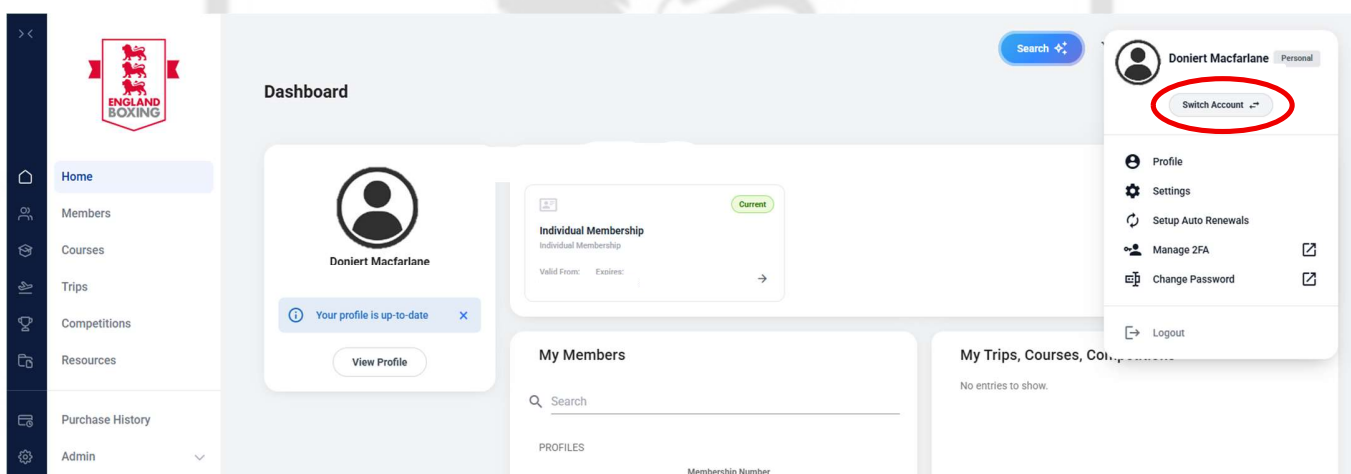

1. Head to the Locker and log into your individual profile

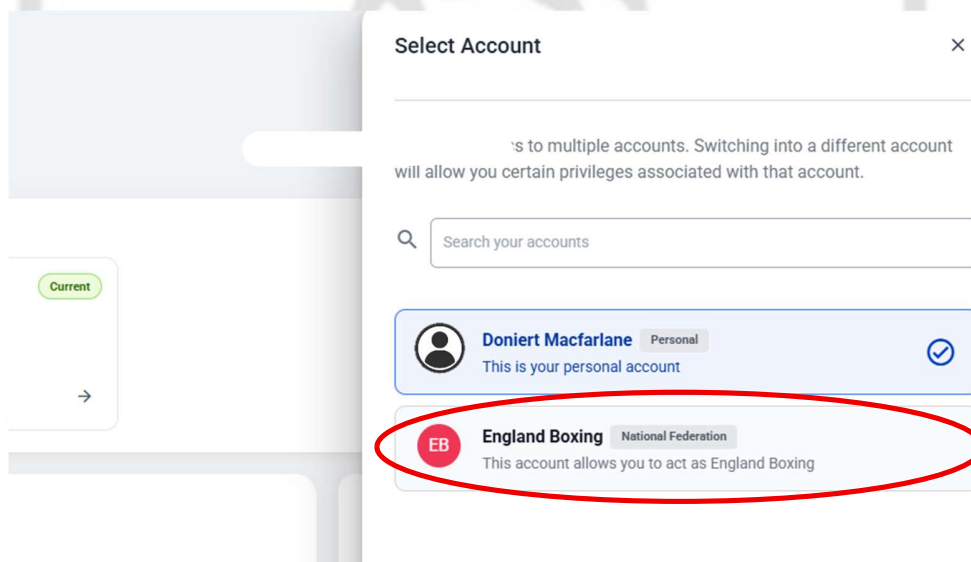

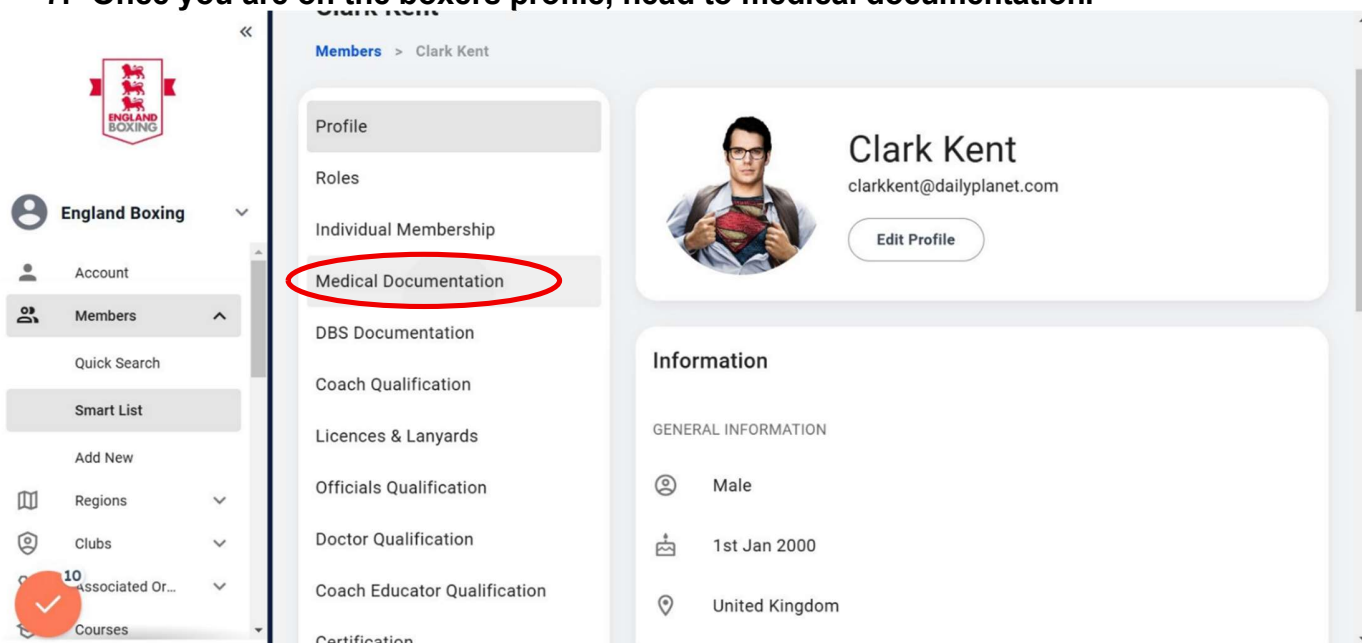

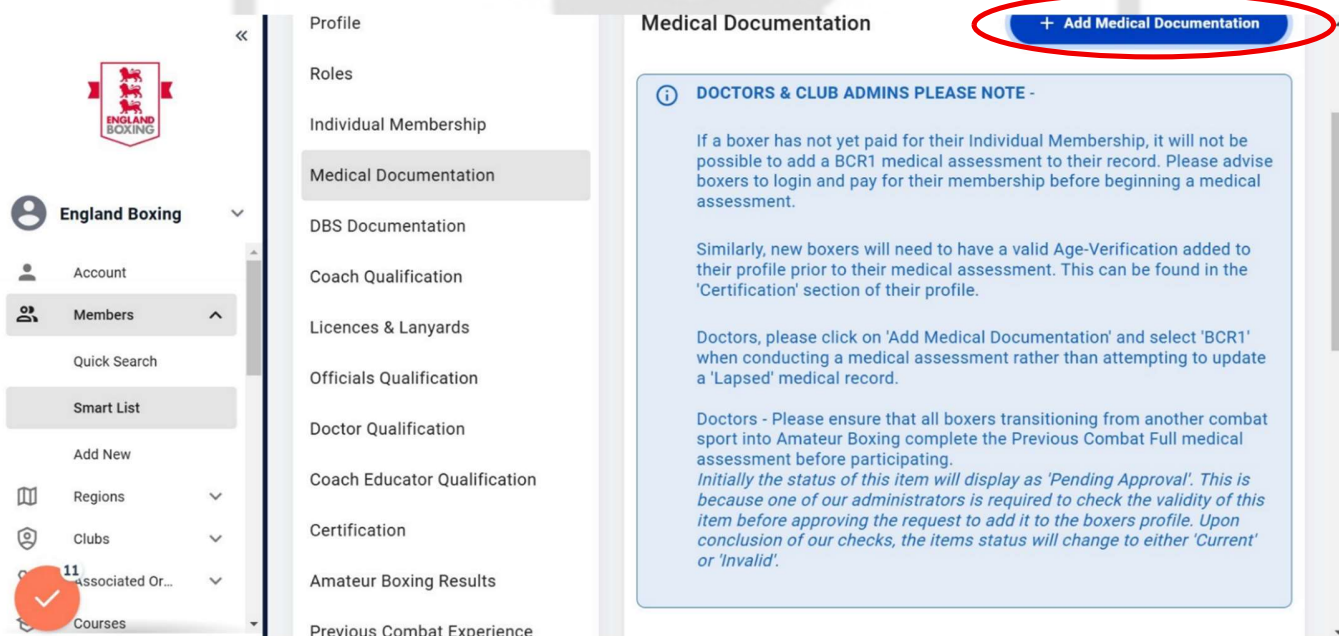

How to input a medical as an England Boxing Registered Doctor

7. Once you are on the boxers profile, head to medical documentation.



8. Once you are in the medical documentation section, click add medical documentation



9. **You will need the Competitive BCR1 medical documentation type.** For recreational, Tier 1 boxers, Recreational BCR1 is required.

The welcome screen outlines the difference between each type of medical documentation

- Full Medical (Amateur Boxers ONLY) - for first-time Medicals and those whose last Boxing Medical was longer than 24 months ago AND they have no Previous Combat Experience since their last Boxing Medical
- Full Medical (Pro Boxer / Combat Sports Fighter) - for re-medicals of those who have competed in Pro Boxing and/or other Combat Sports since their last Boxing Medical
- Re-Medical - for re-medicals of those who have no Pro Boxing and/or other Combat Sport Experience since their last Boxing Medical AND that Medical was less than 24 months ago.

When completing a BCR1, you will be presented with 3 options - please be sure to FIRST ask the following questions of the Boxer:

- Is this your first Boxing Medical?
- If no, when was your last Boxing Medical?
- Have you any Previous Combat or Pro Boxing Experience since your last Medical?

Based on those answers, please then select the relevant option from the list:

1. **Full Medical (Amateur Boxers ONLY)** - for first-time Medicals and those whose last Boxing Medical was longer than 24 months ago AND they have no Previous Combat Experience since their last Boxing Medical
2. **Full Medical (Pro Boxer / Combat Sports Fighter)** - for re-medicals of those who have competed in Pro Boxing and/or other Combat Sports since their last Boxing Medical
3. **Re-Medical** - for re-medicals of those who have no Pro Boxing and/or other Combat Sport Experience since their last Boxing Medical AND that Medical was less than 24 months ago
