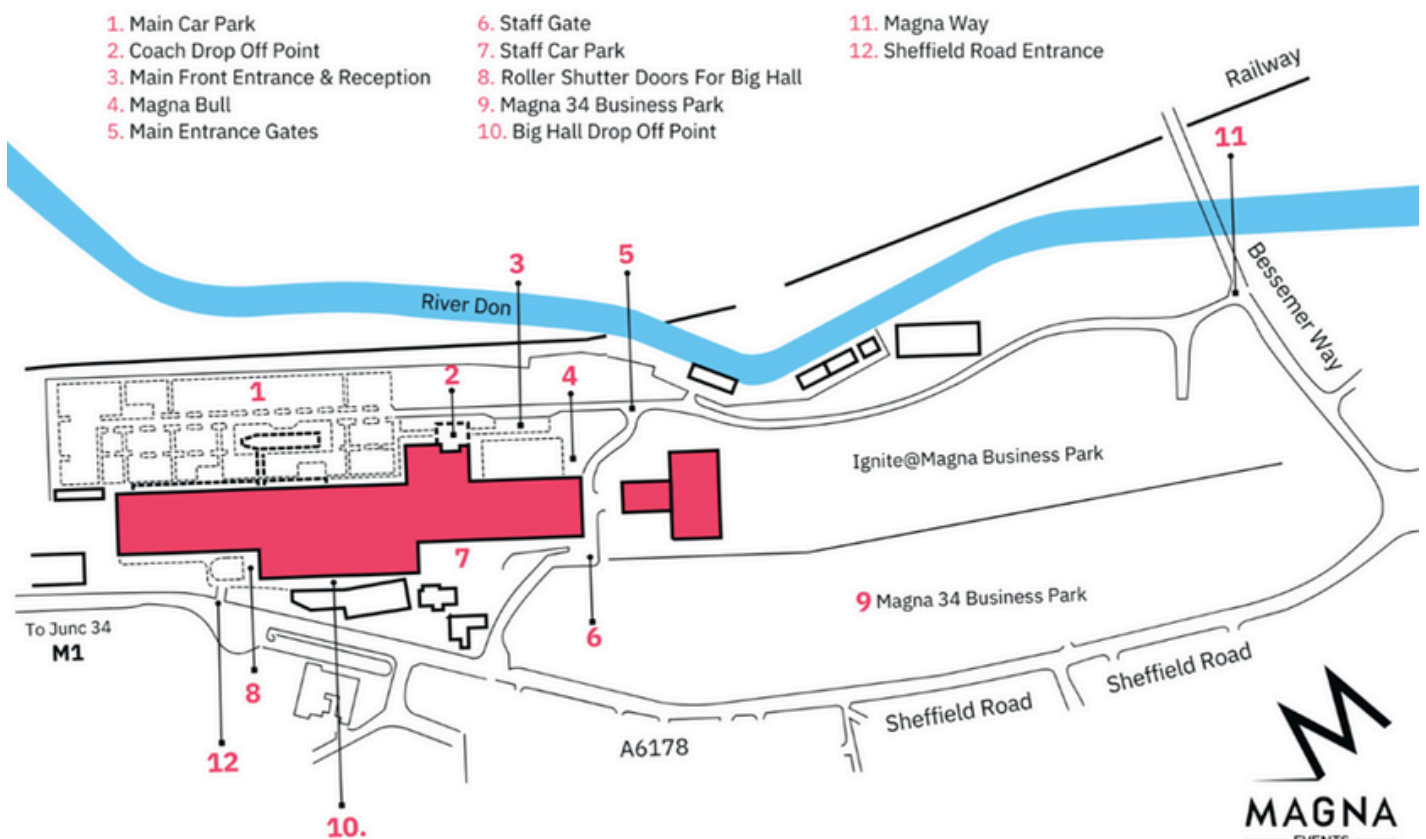

FEAR NOTHING

Welcome to the key information circular for the England Boxing National Youth Championships 2026, to be held at The Magna Science Adventure Centre, Magna Way, Templeborough, Rotherham, S60 1FD on Saturday 7th (Semi Finals) and Sunday 8th (Finals) February 2026.

The Magna Science Adventure Centre offers ample free parking on-site, accessible using the postcode S60 1FD. Kindly ensure all vehicles are parked responsibly within the designated bays. Please be aware that pedestrian access is via Sheffield Road, postcode S60 1DX.

This event is for Youth male and female boxers, aged 16 – 18 years, in a wide range of weight categories.

These final stages of the event are staged by England Boxing, but we would like to recognise the extensive work put in by all those involved in the regional rounds in the run up to this weekend and thank them for their efforts.


ACCREDITATION/WEIGHING IN

Accreditation and weighing in for boxers will take place at The Magna Science Adventure Centre, Magna Way, Templeborough, Rotherham, S60 1FD between **8:00am – 10:00am** on both Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th February 2026.

Boxers and coaches must be at the venue in good time to be weighed in and to carry out their medicals. The scales will close at **10:00am prompt** on both days.

Please note that boxers only need to weigh in on the day they are boxing. Any boxer who does not weigh-in and attend the medical on the days they are required to do so will be withdrawn from the Championships.

All boxers must bring their digital BCR1 and gumshield with them (gumshields can now be of any colour) to the initial weigh-in and to all subsequent rounds. Due to the number of boxers entered in this event, only one coach of the same gender from any one club will be allowed to enter the weigh-in room with their boxer(s).




Each morning during accreditation, boxers and coaches will receive their daily accreditation wristbands. Boxers and coaches will need to show their wristband to access the field of play and other areas within the venue such as the allocated warm up areas.

BOXER REQUIREMENTS

All England Boxing registered boxers must ensure the following items are up to date in the Locker in preparation for the National Youth Championships 2026:

- Profile picture uploaded showing only the boxer (passport style).
- Digital BCR1 Red QR code ready on your device. To get a valid QR code you'll need:
 - 1.Current age verification uploaded
 - 2.Current membership registered to an England Boxing club
 - 3.No medical suspensions
 - 4.Pregnancy indemnity form (if applicable).
- Current, in-date medical covering the entire duration of the event.
- Declaration of all previous combat and EB bouts.

England Boxing will provide appropriate headguards and gloves for all contests throughout the semifinals and finals. Only World Boxing approved hand wraps must be worn.



In accordance with World Boxing rules a bandana or hair net must be worn to ensure hair is secure throughout the bout. Any false eyelashes or nails must be removed prior to boxing.

COACH REQUIREMENTS

All coaches must ensure the following items are up to date in the Locker in preparation for the National Youth Championships 2026:

- Profile picture uploaded showing only the coach (passport style).
- Digital purple Coach Licence QR code on your device. To get a valid QR code you'll need:
 - 1.Current membership registered to an England Boxing club
 - 2.In-date First Aid certificate
 - 3.In-date Safeguarding certificate
 - 4.In-date DBS certificate.

All coaches will be required to show their fully in-date Locker profile with valid First Aid, DBS and Safeguarding dates to be granted accreditation.

The number of accredited coaches eligible for this competition is based on the number of entered boxers as follows;



- 1 boxer = 3 coaches
- 2 boxers = 4 coaches
- 3 or more boxers = 6 coaches
- Only 3 coaches are permitted to second a boxer.

Please note the numbers above will be strictly enforced during accreditation, in accordance with the regulations outlined in the England Boxing rulebook.

BOXING TIMINGS

On both Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th February 2026, boxing will commence from 11:30am. A 30-minute interval will take place in each ring at a specified time, outlined on the finalised bout lists.

Bouts will commence from lightest weight categories ascending; Youth Cadets, followed by Youth.

PROGRAMME

The official draw will be released on or before Thursday 5th February 2026 on the England Boxing website, and on England Boxing's social media channels.

Please note that the programme will be dependent on all boxers making the weight and passing the doctor's examination.

The confirmed bout order for each day will be promulgated on completion of the draw for the semifinals and, following those results, for the finals.

There will be two boxing rings in place on all days.



SPECTATOR TICKETS

Spectator tickets are to be purchased through the England Boxing Online Box Office in advance of the event (click [here](#) or scan the QR code below to access).

We strongly recommend purchasing tickets in advance of travelling to ensure entry on the day, and fast track the queues. A limited number of tickets **may** be available at the door (card payments only), subject to capacity.

- Age requirements and valid ID checks will apply to all ticket holders.
- Tickets are non-transferable, non-exchangeable, and non-refundable.
- Children and juniors must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Damaged or broken wristbands will not be replaced. Swapping or exchanging wristbands is strictly prohibited and will result in refused entry.
- Tickets can only be redeemed on the day(s) they are valid for.

Wristbands will be issued to spectators after showing a valid ticket at the entrance, either directly from your smartphone, or a printed version of the original ticket.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Please note that England Boxing photographers and videographers will be capturing footage on both days of the event that may include capturing images of participants/spectators. By attending as a participant/spectator, you agree this imagery and videography can be used by England Boxing and other media outlets.


Any spectator using a professional camera or filming equipment in the spectator seating area without England Boxing's knowledge will not be permitted to do so. Anyone who does so will be asked to stop and may be removed by security.

24-hour CCTV is also in operation at The Magna Science Adventure Centre. Images are recorded for the purpose of crime prevention and detection, and public safety.

ENGLAND PERFORMANCE PATHWAY

Pathway Recruitment

Open class winners will automatically qualify for a place on the England Pathway. Other boxers identified by England Coaches from semi-finals onwards will also be notified of their invite to pathway.



GB Three Nations 2026

This year's tournament will be held in Scotland in June. Open class champions from international weight categories will qualify to represent England and will be notified in due course.


