



ENGLAND BOXING CODE OF CONDUCT

Easy Read – Document Summary

Who does the Code of Conduct apply to?

The Code can be used with **any member** of England Boxing. It is used to protect everyone in the sport of boxing and explains the **behaviour** expected from people within the boxing community.

How is the Code of Conduct used?

The first part of the Code is for everyone in the sport to understand. If you have a **specific role** such as a boxer, official, coach or doctor, then there is also information for you to understand.

What is a minimum standard of conduct?

Throughout the Code the words '**minimum standards of conduct**' are written. This is what England Boxing expect all members to do and will help people **choose the behaviour** they use to each other. If the minimum standards are used by members, then the all people in boxing will be happy and have good relationships.

Why is this summary separate from the Code of Conduct?

This page is produced as an easy-to-read guide to the full document to help all members understand how the longer Code is used by England Boxing. The language used is simpler and more accessible, but this document does not replace the Code.
