



## 2025 ENGLAND BOXING ANNUAL OVERVIEW OF CLEAN SPORT ACTIVITIES

The Compliance Team are over time amending the reporting cycle for both internal and external reports. In line with these amendments and changes to the current Clean Sport Education Strategy Implementation Plan, the Clean Sport reporting period now runs annually from July to June each year. In order to amend this cycle, the June 2026 report will be an 18 month annual overview. Therefore this report for 2025 is an abridged version.

### **UKAD's Assurance Framework**

The annual submission made to UK Anti-Doping (UKAD) has been completed as of February 2025 and correlates with smaller submissions made throughout the year based on Test Distribution Planning and Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUEs). EB has now fully adopted the UKAD Implementation Plan template which supports the requirements of both UKAD's Education and Assurance Teams.

### **Education**

Education opportunities are categorised by WADA as '*values-based education*', '*awareness*', '*information*' and '*anti-doping education*'. EB has adopted this categorisation through the delivery of broad education material to members, reflecting the updates to the Implementation Plan as well as utilising the Comms Team to support with access to a wider audience.

#### *Anti-Doping Education*

Seven face to face 100% Me Workshops have been delivered in 2025 to a total of 93 attendees. This comprised the EB Senior Squad who are a mandatory group requiring education at least every two years and optional groups including Performance Pathway boxers and coaches.

Additionally a suite of free to access e-Learning courses is also available through the UKAD website and the Clean Sport Hub. These have also been promoted to EB staff and the wider membership with 28 e-Learning courses completed.

#### *Values-Based Education*

Values-based education (VBE) has been embedded into the delivery of workshops through the use of scenario based learning, alongside the alignment of UKAD's 100% Me values with EB's own values and Strategic Plan. VBE is heavily relied on when delivering education to athletes and ASP returning from a sanction.

#### *Awareness*

The Comms Team continue to be excellent at promoting clean sport through social media and the website and an Annual Comms Plan is in place with key messages to be shared each month. These

reflect the need for EB to share Prohibited List and TUE Pool updates which were posted out in the summer and autumn of 2025.

#### *Information*

The EB website and clean sport page provide awareness information and EB policy relates back to this page, to provide current guidance and useful signposting. Boxers in the National TUE Pool (Senior Squad) were all directly emailed the updates to the TUE Pool requirements in July 2025 with a follow up email sent in December 2025 to advise of the annual updates to WADA's Prohibited List published on 01 January 2026.

### **Testing & Results Management**

EB's Senior Squad form the National TUE Pool and EB's transition to World Boxing as the International Federation is now complete. No boxers currently form part of the National Registered Testing Pool (NRTP) for EB.

There have been no published ADRV's within EB and the Compliance Team remains in contact with UKAD's Intelligence & Investigations Team in order to share information between parties.

### **Summary**

Data collated from education activity is collated bi-monthly to report back to sub-committees and the Board. This includes feedback on targets set in the Implementation Plan and shared with UKAD. 2025 data indicates a positive year for EB, with increased education activity and UKAD's Assurance Framework requirements having been met.

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
