OVERVIEW OF ENGLAND BOXING

WHO WE ARE

England Boxing Ltd, is the National Governing Body for amateur boxing in England, one of the oldest sports in the world and one which has featured in the ancient and modern Olympic Games since 1904.

With its own heritage going back to the 1880s, including the first national competition in 1881, the organisation is responsible for promoting and developing the sport at all levels, from grassroots through to the England talent pathway and, in turn, passing prospective medallists on to GB Boxing. The organisation is a member of World Boxing/AIBA and EUBC, the World and European governing bodies respectively.

The National Governing Body is navigating a period of rapid transformation, and a draw system will provide a more streamlined process for competition management

BACKGROUND

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Historically, England Boxing uses a lengthy system to conduct a draw, the details are then manually input into a spreadsheet which is shared online as a bout list. Each step of the process takes a lot of time and requires extensive checks at each stage. We are hopeful that the right candidate can produce a system to streamline this task by reducing time taken and eliminating the possibility of mistakes being made


THE REQUIREMENT

England Boxing, the National Governing Body for amateur boxing in England, invites proposals from qualified and experienced software providers to design and build a system that allows us to input an excel document of entries and convert into a matrix which will then be drawn into bouts, including preliminary rounds to finals, including the production of bout lists and an online function that allows members to see updates in real time.



THE OUTCOME

The primary objective of this tender is to engage with a professional organisation who can:

- Provide a content platform that displays England Boxing branding to the highest standards, befitting a sporting event of importance
 - Enhance viewer experience through clear matrix uploads.
 - Create a user-friendly interface to allow members to view changes in real time.
 - A function that allows a simple input of data from an excel spreadsheet,
 - The capability to organise and sort names into a draw.
 - Download the draw into easy to read bout lists and sort in orders of weight (and or category)
 - Deliver a personal and professional service to England Boxing, understanding the needs of each event, and addressing and resolving issues promptly as they arise.

It shall remain the responsibility of the Tenderer to ensure that their quotation will reach the email address above on or before the deadline. Quotations that are received after the deadline indicated above, for whatever reason, shall not be considered for evaluation. Pitches will take place from w/c 22nd June.

ASSESSMENT

In order to be successful, there must be a clear demonstration of the following:

- A system that has the capability to produce a matrix of entrants from an excel spreadsheet
 - A functionality to compile the data and produce a draw
 - Produce bout lists that can be uploaded to an online portal through a link on the EB website
 - Archive that stores past competitions
 - Scope to advertise sponsors online alongside draws
 - Clear understanding of data required to produce above requirements
 - Value for money: The value that the tenderer will bring to the organisation (the lowest bid may not always be the one to be selected if other benefits are given)
 - Availability – available to deliver services in a timely manner and communicate effectively
 - Fee – the fee basis and the cost for support services
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
